# BOND '26

Based on the recommendation of the parents, staff and taxpayers who served on the Community Advisory Committee (CAC), the SCUC ISD Board of Trustees has called a three-proposition school bond election, totaling **\$295 million**, for **Saturday, May 2, 2026**.

## What is in the 2026 May Bond proposal?



### PROP A GENERAL FACILITIES **\$230.7 MILLION**

Prop A addresses district-wide improvements such as campus security systems, classrooms and learning spaces, upgraded fine arts, physical education, and play areas, and campus renovations at multiple grade levels.



### PROP B STADIUM FACILITIES **\$55.3 MILLION**

Prop B includes renovations to Lehnhoff Stadium. This proposal also includes stadium turf replacement at Steele High School and stadium turf installation at Corbett Junior High.



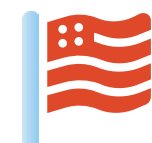
### PROP C TECHNOLOGY DEVICES **\$9.1 MILLION**

Prop C would fund the replacement of student and staff technology, such as computers, iPads, and Chromebooks.
